WHAT DO ANIMALS EAT?

Your parents work hard to make sure that you have healthy food. They know how important it is for you to have good food to keep you strong and give you the energy you need to do your school work and enjoy playing. All animals need food, but they don't all eat the foods that we eat. You may be surprised what some animals eat.

Some are herbivores. Those are animals that eat only plants. Some are carnivores, animals that eat

only animals. You probably eat some plants and some animals. Others animals eat more unusual things—things that you would never consider eating. Some animals are very particular and only eat one food. We would not be happy if we had the same thing for every meal, but some animals only eat one thing.

LET'S LOOK AT A FEW ANIMALS WHO LIVE IN VIRGINIA BEACH WHERE YOU LIVE AND SEE WHAT THEY EAT.



1. **Spiders** are great to have around because they eat insects.
2. **Osprey** have been call fish hawks because their primary food is fish.
3. **Oysters** are attached to other oysters in a reef. What can they eat? They filter particles of phytoplankton from the water, these are plants that are so small we can only see them when there are too many of them in our water.
4. **Herons and Egrets** have long legs that are perfect for walking in tall grasses and shallow water. They eat many different things including crabs, clams, and fish. In this photo, the heron has a crab in its mouth.
5. **Squirrels** eat nuts and seeds. They may carry them in their cheeks back to their nest or store them and come back for them later in the year when food is harder to find.
6. **Monarch Butterfly caterpillars** only eat milkweed plants. If they are unable to find milkweed, they will die.
7. What do you think this **Woodpecker** eats?
